Each week you will receive a selection of hand-harvested produce with a focus on fruit and vegetables of exceptional quality, including many European heirloom varieties. GSA boxes will have a retail value of at least \$25 per week.

As a GSA member, you will receive an invitation to two special farm events, which will be announced later in the season. In addition, visits to the farm are welcomed -- but as we are a working farm, they must be scheduled in advance.

GSA members interested in canning/freezing/processing larger amounts of produce (i.e. flat of berries or box of peaches) receive wholesale pricing for bulk orders. Based on availability; please call ahead to reserve.

A note about GSA accompaniments:

The driving force in our farming approach is a commitment to superior quality with an innovative approach to agricultural and culinary traditions. We have several friends in the local agricultural/culinary community that reflect this passion, and we are delighted to partner with them in bringing you the goods that are the result of our diligent work. Payments for GSA accompaniments go directly to each respective producer; viridian farms does not act as a distributor receiving a commission for any GSA accompaniments.

GSA harvest boxes will be delivered per your specified drop site request on a weekly basis to the following locations. GSA boxes must be picked up during the hours indicated, or they will be donated to the Yamhill County food bank.

Maximum of two vacation credits during the season; requires at least one week advance notice for pick up cancellation.

Full season subscription: May 1

Half season subscriptions, first half of season: May 1

Half season subscriptions, second half of season: July 1

Payment methods accepted are: personal check, cash, and VISA/MC (through PayPal).

Due to the very limited number of subscriptions available, reservations without payment will only be held until payment deadlines. Thereafter, prospective subscribers on our waiting list will be given the opportunity to purchase available memberships.

Please note that due to the nature of sustainable farming, we cannot guarantee that all produce will be available as listed on our web site. We look forward to hearing from you throughout the season, and encourage you to share your thoughts on the GSA experience.
